You will: - Work in collaboration with a designated partner organisation on a group research project - Write-up an impact-research report for your project, which will include actionable recommendations. - Produce a public version of this report and a one-page poster, which will be presented on the Laidlaw Scholars Website. - Learn applied research skills and work with local stakeholders <p>You will be supported by SDG Impact Lab Faculty and staff for the full scope of the project activities and deliverables.</p>
